PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Objective

Build momentum around UHC2030 contribution to secure meaningful outcomes from the UN High-Level Meeting on UHC in 2023 and ensure synergies between HLM preparations, UHC Day and other milestones to promote a shared vision for resilient and equitable health systems and mobilize stakeholders around key actions for 2022-2023.

Expected outcomes

- **Roadmap to UHC HLM 2023.** Steering Committee is updated on the status of vision for UN HLM 2023 and preparation plans in place and provides guidance to leverage opportunities to promote UHC2030 narrative on resilient and equitable health systems based on primary health care as the best way to achieve UHC and health security, including pandemic preparedness and response (PPR).
- **UHC2030 ‘push’ on promoting health systems for UHC and health security.** Steering Committee is updated on progress in UHC2030 vision on health systems for UHC and health security, including specific actions by different constituencies.
- **Navigating the complex political landscape in September 2023.** Steering Committee identifies opportunities to engage with the PPR HLM and TB HLM preparation process, as well as the second SDG Summit, to ensure consistency and mutually reinforcing processes and further push for investments in equitable and resilient health systems with PHC as a foundation to deliver on both UHC and health security goals.
- **Integrating UHC and PPR.** Strategic outreach opportunities are leveraged to promote the links between UHC and PPR and the importance of health systems strengthening, and to address risks of vertical approaches to PPR.
- **Steering committee leadership.** All members of the Steering Committee are fully reconnected and mobilized with a clear understanding of the respective roles of different constituencies ahead of the UN HLM.
- **Resource mobilization.** Steering Committee constituencies demonstrate a commitment to help mobilize the necessary resources for UHC2030 work plan to be fully funded in 2023.
