Effective development cooperation	<ul> <li>Policy brief on contribution to effective development cooperation to support SDG implementation and implications for financial instruments and modalities</li> <li>Existing IHP+ tools updated : JANS, JARS, country compacts, mutual accountability frameworks</li> <li>Demand driven country support for use of tools</li> </ul>
