



## Results from the survey on broadening the scope of IHP+

In April 2016, IHP+ countries were asked the following questions:

### Q. Looking forward: should the IHP+ activities continue either within IHP+ or as part of a broader Universal Health Coverage (UHC) alliance?

No	0%
A few activities should continue	7 %
Yes, with minor changes	83%
Yes, unchanged	10%

### Q. Are you in favour of IHP+ expanding its mandate to also cover issues of coordination, advocacy & accountability in relation to Health System Strengthening and UHC?

No, not at all in favour	0%
Not much in favour	3%
Don't know	0%
Somewhat in favour	10%
Yes, very much in favour	87%

#### MoH&SW The Gambia

“It is the view of the MOH&SW, The Gambia, that the two consortia, i.e. IHP+ and UHC are two powerful alliances that can effectively work together to enhance the ultimate goal of accessing HIGH QUALITY UNIVERSAL HEALTH COVERAGE for all. In addition, IHP+ should support build country capacities towards the achievement of SDG3, target 3.8 by 2030.”

#### MoH Vietnam

“We agree and support for expanding the IHP+ to become UHC alliance. This change can broaden the scope of IHP+ and engage IHP+ members more effectively to the universal health coverage.

In Vietnam, UHC refers to many areas: health insurance, family doctor network, primary health care, grassroots health system, ... we fully support to this initiative and will continue to participate in this process.”

“UHC is what countries are seeking, therefore support for this mandate is necessary.”

“This would be a transition from somewhat abstract and very broad agenda to focused outcomes pertaining to Health Systems Strengthening and UHC.”

“In fact by adopting the mandate for UHC it would reach out to the poorest of the poor.”

### **Anonymous Survey responses from Francophone countries**

“The broadening of the activities related to UHC has a certain added value and will allow IHP+ to better plan efforts and obtain results.”

“The UHC is a global challenge, like attaining the SDGs. It must build on the achievements of IHP + to meet these new challenges. Do not create other alliances because IHP + is already an alliance.”

“From the moment the signatory countries move towards UHC, a widening of the activities of IHP + to UHC seems relevant.”
