

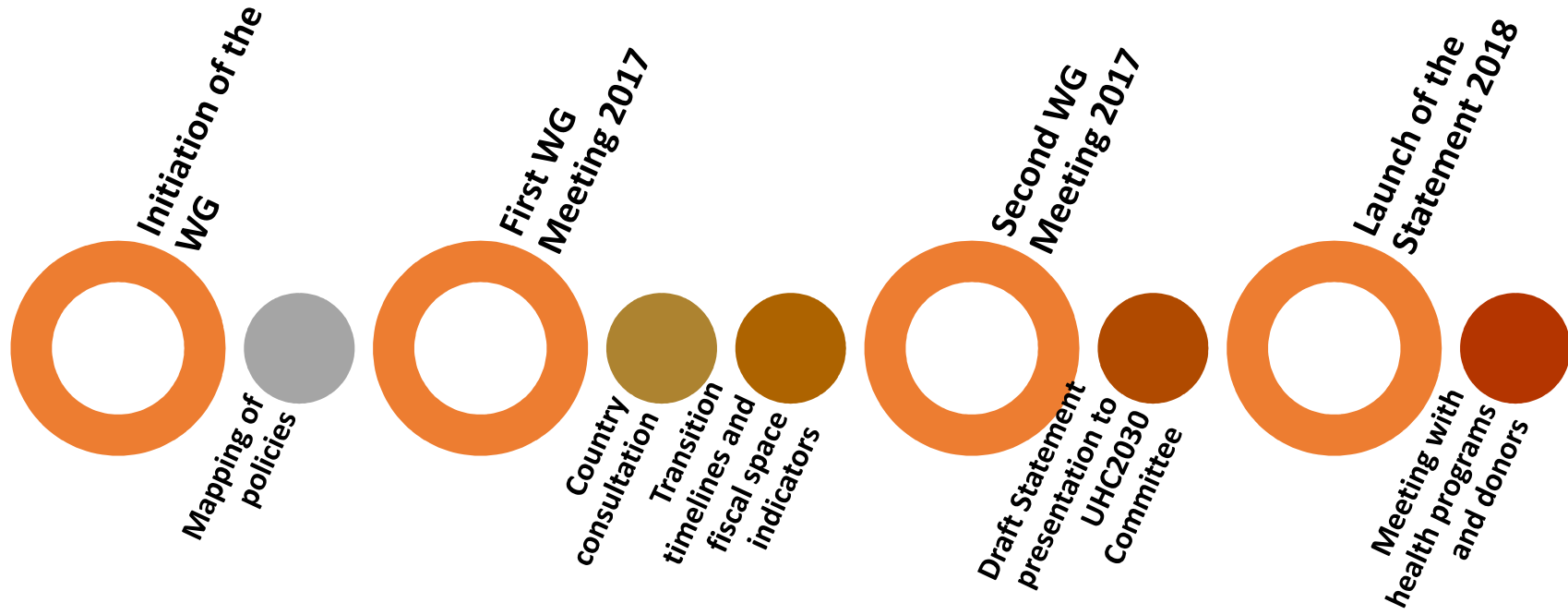

Strengthen national institutions.**

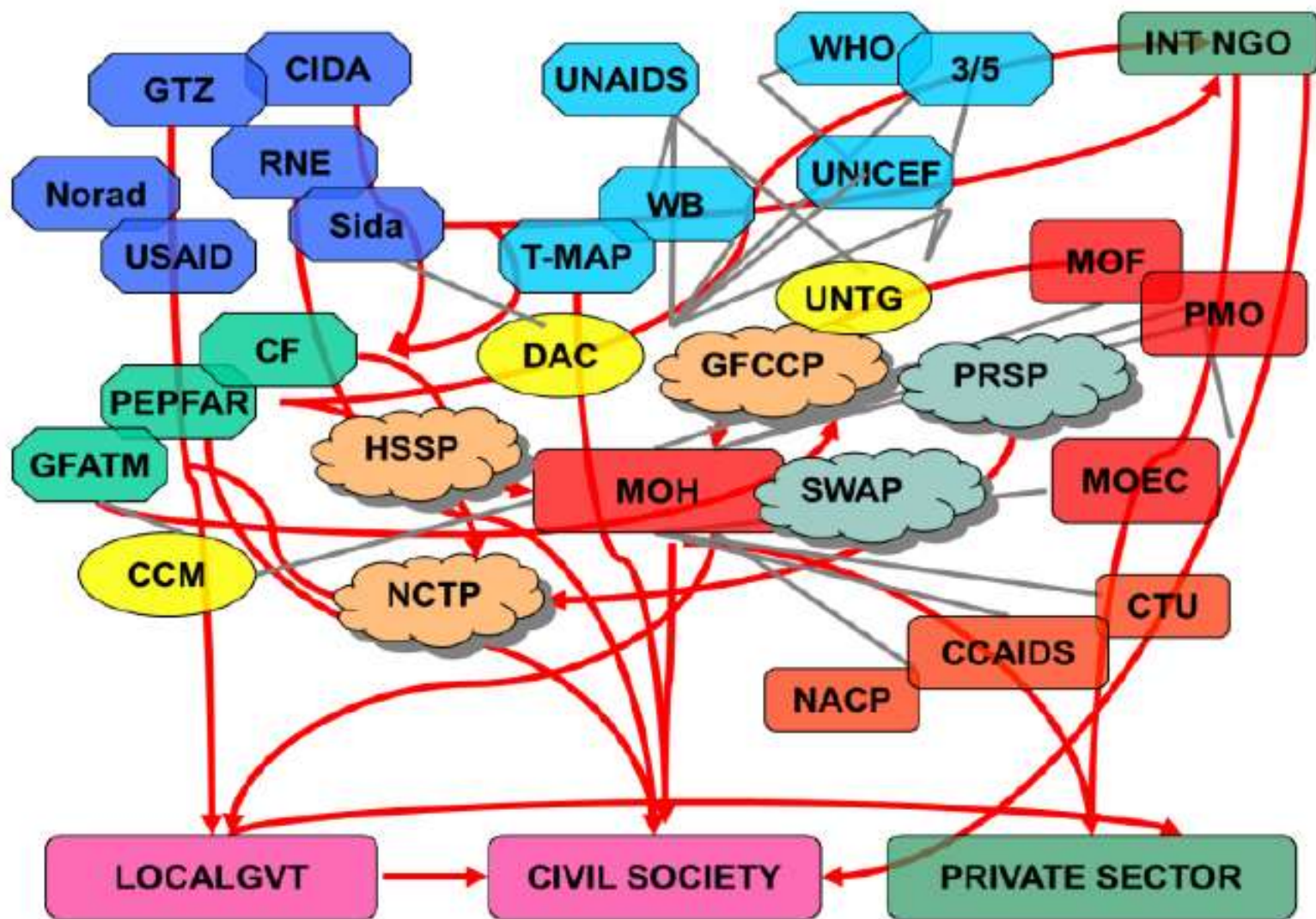

*“Who could be in disagreement?”*

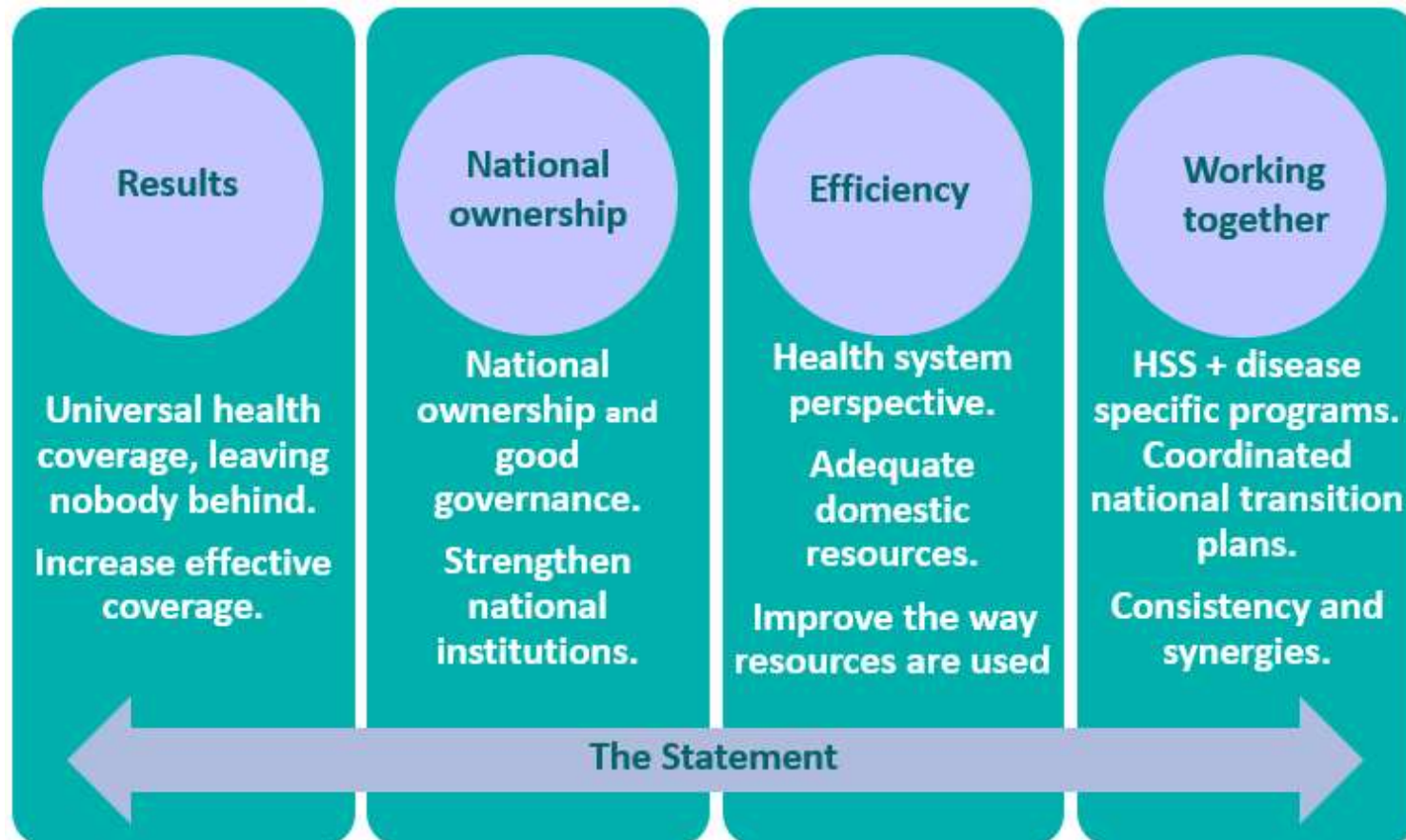
- Provide general orientation
