- Partner driven technical working groups
- Translation of strategies and TORs for technical working groups: from pillars/activities to **outcomes/deliverables**
- Outcomes within a two year process: level of ambition to be commensurate – e.g. **coordination** vs. intended effects of coordination
- Framework for country work: **country value** vs. country level activities

PFM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Good practice of FM harmonisation and alignment - Policy brief on PFM issues in health - Report on lessons learned from support to FM harmonisation and alignment
Fragile and conflict affecting settings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mainstreaming of issues across UHC2030 work and networks - Guidance on improved coordination across development and humanitarian stakeholders + support to 2-3 countries/context - Problem solving support with peer exchange on critical HS related bottlenecks (e.g. health workers salaries)
Sustainability and transition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 knowledge sharing products (co-authored by TWG members) - Guidance and good practice principles for sustainability and transition from external finance - Coordinated country support for transition in 3 countries
Health systems assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Common template to present results from health systems assessment + recommendation for a country driven process - A knowledge platform around health systems performance to support cross-country learning
Multisector approach for UHC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Broad consultation to draw attention to the importance of the health sector taking steps to building capacity for multisector efforts for health as part of UHC - Policy brief on functions required for multisector efforts - Country case studies on experience linked to national UHC plans
Effective development cooperation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Policy brief on contribution to effective development cooperation to support SDG implementation and implications for financial instruments and modalities - Existing IHP+ tools updated : JANS, JARS, country compacts, mutual accountability frameworks - Demand driven country support for use of tools
