### ACCREDITATION AND REGISTRATION PROCESS

**Step 1: Accreditation is required first.** Only accredited organizations can pursue registration for the Hearing and for the UN HLM. The list of applicants seeking accreditation will be circulated to UN Member States by the President of the UN General Assembly for approval on a non-objection basis.

**Step 2: Registration for the Multi-stakeholder Hearing:** Only accredited entities will be able to register for the Multi-stakeholder Hearing once registration opens.

**Step 3: Registration for the UN HLM:** Only accredited entities will be able to register for the UN HLM when it opens in summer 2019.

**Registration for the Interactive Multi-Stakeholder Hearing and the UN HLM will be done separately,** in advance of each meeting, and will be announced on the UN website and through the UN PGA, WHO and UHC2030 newsflashes and websites.

*Be aware that only those non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, philanthropic foundations, academic institutions, medical associations and private sector entities which have been accredited will be allowed to register for either meeting.*

*UN Member States, UN entities, and non-governmental organizations in consultative status with ECOSOC may register for either meeting directly, once registration opens.*



## ACCREDITATION [CLOSED]

The accreditation process to participate in the interactive Multi-stakeholder Hearing on 29 April 2019 and the UN High-Level Meeting on UHC (UN HLM) on 23 September 2019 has **now closed for applications**. Please be aware that **there is only one accreditation process**, valid for both the multi-stakeholder hearing AND the UN HLM. *There will not be a separate accreditation process later for the UN HLM on UHC.*

The following stakeholders: non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions, philanthropic foundations, medical associations and the private sector – **WITHOUT ECOSOC STATUS** – must submit their accreditation requests through the UN system.

1. **Accreditation is mandatory to enable registration** for the hearing and/or the UN HLM
2. **Accreditation requests must be made ONLY on behalf of organizations or institutions** & not as individuals
3. Applying for accreditation requires important information on organizations that apply – such as an annual report, by-laws, motivation letter – please allow enough time to provide all these.
4. UN member states, UN entities, and non-governmental organizations in consultative status with ECOSOC, do not need to apply for accreditation (**please see list of institutions accredited with ECOSOC status [here](#)**).

## REGISTRATION [NOW OPEN FOR THE MULTISTAKEHOLDER HEARING ON APRIL 29<sup>TH</sup>]

1. **Registration to attend the Multi-stakeholder Hearing or UN HLM is mandatory** for all organizations in consultative status with ECOSOC and all specially-accredited entities.
2. **Registration must be done on an individual basis**. If multiple individuals from an entity wish to attend the, each individual must register separately.
3. Each entity may recommend up to **5 representatives** for participation.
4. Depending on space, a maximum of 3 participants per entity may be allowed in the Hearing at any given time. If required, secondary tickets will be issued to delegations. *Therefore, letters approving participants should indicate three primary participants and up to two secondary participants.*
5. Please note that there are **two** separate registration portals:
  - Those in **consultative status with ECOSOC** must register [HERE](#)
  - Those **approved for special-accreditation** must register [HERE](#)
6. **Those entities wishing to make a statement should register [HERE](#) by 24 April 2019.**
7. Kindly note due to time limitations, **joint statements will be prioritized**.
8. Registration does not guarantee the opportunity to make an intervention.

## PARTICIPATION IN THE MULTI-STAKEHOLDER HEARING

The Multi-stakeholder Hearing is part of the preparatory process for the UN HLM. It will provide a platform for the inclusive, active and substantive engagement of civil society and other relevant stakeholders. It will also serve as another opportunity for participants to make recommendations towards the UN HLM in order to support and to inform Member States in the development of the UN HLM outcome document.

The World Health Organization and UHC2030 are supporting the President of the General Assembly in the organization of the hearing.

Please note that applying for accreditation and registration does not guarantee entry into either meeting. Applicants who have been approved to attend will be notified in due course.
